

How does your doctor diagnose a Primary Immunodeficiency (PI), such as APDS?

FREQUENT,

Because the **immune system doesn't work as it should**, people with a PI, such as APDS, may have more frequent and recurrent infections that may cause them to visit their doctor more often.

People with a PI can have infections that are hard to treat or that keep coming back.

A PI such as APDS can cause problems throughout the body, so people can have a **wide range of different symptoms**. This is one reason why it can be difficult for doctors to recognize APDS or another PI.

If you think that you or someone you care for has experienced two or more of the 10 Warning Signs of PI or the **10 Warning Signs of APDS**, your doctor may be able to help. Genetic tests are available to help your doctor provide answers and a possible diagnosis.
